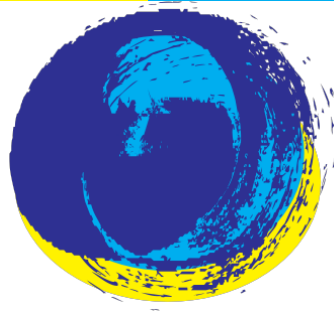


2015 BULLYING AWARENESS CAMPAIGN STUDENT CONTEST

- WHO:** Carson residents in grades 3–12
- WHAT:** The contest asks you to think about how to build schools without bullying. What you can do to make your school and community places where people are accepted and appreciated for who they are.
- HOW:** Creating a bullying prevention and awareness campaign through original artistic and media expression, including: drawings, paintings, photography, cartoons, computer art, short video public service announcements (PSAs), and any other way you can be creative. Each winner in high school, middle school and elementary school will receive \$150 towards bullying prevention and awareness activities at their school and recognition from the City of Carson. *If you can't easily email or mail your campaign entry, take a few photos of the project and send those instead.*
